3rd party guarantor

You begin the application process, submit documents, and are planning out the new pieces of furniture that you're going to get for your new apartment, only to have the landlord come back to you and say that you don't qualify on your own but that you could use a guarantor. You realize you don't have one....what do you do? Well hopefully you had an idea of your financial picture/situation beforehand and this isn't necessarily a shock to you. If it is, not to worry - Insurent and TheGuarantors are at your service! But what are they? Insurent and TheGuarantors are companies that specialize in guaranteeing leases for tenants who don't qualify on their own nor have guarantors of their own. A good number of landlords will accept these entities (this is definitely a question to ask the building in the beginning if you think that you might be in this situation). How do you qualify to be able to have one of these companies guarantee your lease? To start, you will generally need to make 27.5x the monthly rent or have 50x the monthly rent in the bank. They will ask you to fill out a basic application that includes your contact information, financial picture, and the place that you're looking to rent. To accompany this application, they will ask for documentation (usually an employment letter, most recent tax return, photo id, and most recent bank statement). Based on your entire package, they will determine whether you qualify and if so, what the fee would be in order for them to do so. The fee generally ranges from 55%-110% of a month's rent. Once you qualify, you will receive a guarantee letter from them that you will need to send to the building to confirm and once they confirm, you will be good to go! Banks often serve as guarantors on behalf of certain clients, but, just as often, private parties serve as guarantors and promise payment on private loans. For example, lenders may fear that your income may not be high enough to meet your payments if you encounter any unexpected financial setbacks.Laws governing who may serve as a guarantor vary from state to state.
