How to farm good decorations mhw

One of the many amazing things you get to learn in the monster hunter world is decoration farming. The decorations are extremely valuable items that are introduced into the game but not until you have unlocked certain high-rank activities, and that you are accustomed to increasing your power further. The problem with decorations is that they are not easy to find. There are some tedious but effective ways to increase your odds of receiving them. Farming the decorations is a bit slow process but it is a great option. This guide will help you through the process to obtain the decoration farming in MHW. How to Farm Decorations? You receive decorations as rewards from finishing the quests and these are basically little gems. Certain high-rank quests are specifically known to drop these rewards. As decorations could be applied to the very specific type of armor and weapons, you will, therefore, have to get rid of a lower-rank gear. Unless you equip your character player with the appropriate high-rank armor set and weapons, having decorations is entirely futile. There are certain ways you can get your hands on the decorations and can learn how to effectively farm them. The best of these means for farming the decorations is to finish some limited-time event quests. You can find these quests on the quest board. Some of these quests involve slaying smaller monsters. Once, monster hunter world offered a quest that required players to slay 13 Shamos but sadly this mission is no longer available. Although there are other longer and tougher event quests as they consume a lot more time than the simpler quests, choosing them to farm decorations is not really a good idea. - Easier quests are also very rewarding in the sense that you're always likely to get something out of them. A small quest called 'Triple Threat Throwdown' is known to reward players as many as five decorations in a single time and can be easily finished within fifteen minutes. - Higher your hunter rank, the higher your chance of receiving decorations. It is suggested that as your hunter-rank grows into the double digits, you should be looking for what is called 'tempered investigations'. These tempered investigations are believed to be some of the more reliable sources of acquiring decorations. - Another way you can receive the decorations is hunting the elder dragons such as the likes of Zorah Magdaros, and Nergigante. These dragons are all very likely to drop decorations to reward the hunters. The fights, however, could be severely arduous. You can always visit the melding pot to make your low-quality decorations into worthwhile items. The melding pod becomes more useful as you progress through the game's story. It is better to store up the items if you are in the start so that you could increase your funds for the purchase. You must log in or register to reply here. At the time the focus was on gems and other rare monster drops, but there was also an interesting detail about decorations that many may not have picked up on. Decorations, for those that might not be familiar, are the jewels that slot into armor and weapons in Monster Hunter World. Each jewel gives one point to a specific skill or fully unlocks a skill if the rarity is high enough. But getting those higher rarity decorations is not so easy. Most figured that the best route towards high rarity decorations would be tempered elder dragon investigations. After all, these are the toughest challenge for HR 50+ players and they have a chance of rewarded streamstones for weapon and armor augments. However, it is the higher chance for streamstones that may be conflicting with those decoration chances. So for those players looking for rarity 7 and rarity 8 decorations, they want to focus on threat level 2 tempered investigations and not elder dragons. Threat level 2 investigations are any fight with a tempered monster from the latter portion of the story mode. They also include fights with multiple tempered monsters, but the best way to single out a threat level 2 is by looking at the required level for the investigation. If the investigation requires Hunter Rank 30 or above then it is threat level 2. Any investigation that requires HR 50 and above should have an elder dragon in it. The reason players want to focus on these threat level 2 investigations is because they have a better chance of dropping warped feystones. While not the highest rarity, the warped feystones seem to offer the rarity 7 and 8 decorations at a better rate than the worn do. In essence, players want to focus on the second-from-the-top rarity tier in the hopes of getting the decorations they want. There is some debate about whether it is ultimately still better to do tempered elder dragon investigations than threat level 2, but it seems the increase in drop rates from elder dragons is minimal. Moreover, focusing on threat level 2 investigations gives endgame players more variety in their hunts. Chances are, if you have been in the endgame for a while you are tired of fighting Vaal Hazaak and Kushala Daora over and over again. However, if the ultimate goal is augmenting armor or weapons then elder dragons are the best route to warrior and hero's streamstones. It ultimately depends what the player wants in the end. About The Author Anthony Taormina (5496 Articles Published) More From Anthony Taormina Monster Hunter World jewels will make or break your build for end-game!If you're hovering near Monster Hunter World's end-game, or even at that point, you've no doubt encountered the Monster Hunter World jewels — or “decorations” — as the game likes to call ‘em. If you're unfamiliar with it or do not know how to “farm” them, and properly use, MP1st has you covered.What are Decorations?In Monster Hunter World, Decorations are gems that give added abilities and buffs existing ones, and can be placed in High Rank armor and weapons. These abilities range from having specific damage to an element, added critical hit bonus, +attack damage and more.Decorations will be one of the main components of your final end-game build, since not only will you be aiming to get tier 3 ones, but they can make or break your character as well. Even the armor you choose in High Rank will be determined (somewhat) by how many slots it has for Decorations and for what tiers.Not familiar with tiers? Decorations have three tiers (1, 2, 3), and the higher the tier, the better buff it gives. Armor and weapon sockets have tiers tied to them as well, so tier 3 sockets can have tiers 1-3 Decorations slotted into them, while tier 1 sockets can only accommodate tier 1 gems.Got that? Good.Where to obtain and farm these?Decorations are dropped by almost every HR mission fight, and even for some optional and investigations. You'll see them at the end of match recap rewards recap screen, and once you appraise them, you'll see what rarity it is, and what abilities it can buff or offer. Note that do NOT sell your Decorations even if it's being offered to you in the game's in-game menu. You will need all your Decorations (yes, even the crappy ones), down the line, which we'll get to in a bit.Note that do not meld decorations. You won't need to, since the items on the list are Decorations you'll easily obtain just by completing missions and earning feystones (Decorations that haven't been appraised). You will need all your Decorations once you've killed the final boss and have seen the credits roll.As of today, there's a mission under "Events" called "Triple Threat Throwdown" where you'll need to fight a Great Girros, Great Jagras and a Dodogama in one arena. It's much easier than it sounds, and you have the arena armaments to help you out. Completing theseHow to get the good stuff?You'll notice that you're still getting the usual tier 1 Decorations while you're progressing from HR15 all the way until you reach HR40+. It's infuriating but the light at the end of the tunnel is near. Once you've beaten the mission "Beyond the Blasting Scales," where you're tasked to defeat two tempered Bazelgeuse, you'll then have access to finding tempered footprints scattered throughout the Ancient Forest, Wildspire Waste, etc. These footprints are blue, and once you've collected enough, you'll be able to look for tempered enemies, which will always (or almost always) drop Decorations once you've defeated them.Kill enough tempered monsters (and reach HR49) and you'll then again access to the mission "Thunderous Rumble in the Highlands" where you're ordered to slay a tempered Kirin! This is easier said than done, but once you've crossed the HR50 threshold, you'll then gain access to the good and awesome Decorations. Beating monsters won't guarantee you'll get the good stuff, but you'll see the heavy-hitters drop here and there, rather than not at all (if you haven't hit HR50) Once you've beaten the final boss Xeno'jiva, you'll gain access to the "First Wyverian Ritual" at the Elder Melder. Remember those crappy Decorations you've held on to? Yeah, now you're going to need each and every one of 'em to create new ones! That said, the ingredients to create them need to be farmed by killing tempered monsters. Streamstone Shards, Streamstones, and Gleaming Streamstones are needed to craft new Decorations via the Elder Melder that will grant you better (in theory) Decorations from the ones you've collected that you don't like or use.Note that the outcome is purely random, and it doesn't matter which Decorations you put in the mix. So if you have an Attack Decoration, or something as valuable, don't put them in there, alright?To create new, and more powerful Decorations, you'll need research points, existing Decorations, and the shards.Well, there you go.
