That's why it's called the systemless root method. Before you get started with Magisk, make sure that: You have access to a PC/Mac with ADB and Fastboot installed. The target Android device is bootloader unlocked. For Samsung devices, unlocking the bootloader will disable Knox. Step 1: Determine the boot image type. Download the latest version of Magisk from the project's GitHub repository. Since the Magisk APK is hosted outside the Google Play Store, you may need to allow downloading apps from unknown sources and then manually install the downloaded package. Once installed, open the Magisk app. You should see the following screen: Now we need to write down the values for the following parameters: Step 2: Location of the boot image In order to flash the boot image of your device, you need to extract it from the official firmware packages. If you are using a custom ROM such as LineageOS, the zip file contains a bootable image. Option 1: You have access to the merged recovery messages file. If you have a device that is still using partition scheme A, you can find the boot.img file directly in the merged recovery message file. Just extract it with an appropriate archive program. Pay attention to the boot.img file in the POCO M3 recovery ZIP file. If the device uses an A/B partition scheme, the boot image and other partition images are additionally combined into a file named Fuel.bin, as shown below. The Google Pixel 5 recovery lock contains a bootloader. We strongly recommend choosing an extractor written in GO, as it is cross-platform and actively developed.
