These settings are the following: System: The narrator will only read the system messages. These are the notifications and other command outputs that appear when you do something in the game. This excludes all messages written by other players.Chat: The chat setting of the narrator is helpful for when you are playing with other people. The Minecraft narrator will read the messages that these other players send to chat when this is on. In a sense, this will help you hear what these other people are saying. It will not read out any of the system messages for you.All: This option is if you want both system and chat messages to be read aloud by the narrator. This will make sure that you don't miss a single thing that enters the chatbox, whether from another player or a notification from the system.Off: Of course, this doesn't count as a setting for the Minecraft narrator per se, but it is the fourth state that you can put it into.
