Here are some tips for looking like a pro:1. Get the right lights. Overhead lighting is the worst kind of lighting for video conferences because it makes shadows under your eyes. You want the lens to be right at eye level. A tripod can get you there and hold the camera to capture the triangle of your forehead to your left shoulder and right shoulder in the frame. 3. Look presentable. Even if only your face and shoulders are in the frame, you never know if you'll need to stand up for some reason. So look decent from head to toe. Put some flattering, solid colors near your face, just like television news anchors do. Check your teeth for remnants of lunch. Make sure the temperature is such that you won't be sweating, and won't need to start taking off layers, which is disconcerting for all watching. Less obvious? "Make sure you've got the right chair," Bailo says. Fidgeting is fine on audio but deadly when you can see someone moving like a hyperactive school boy in the corner of your screen.
